In the 2019 Maharashtra Assembly elections, Nasim Malik of NCP won in this seat defeating Tukaram Ramchandra Kite by a margin of 12,25 which was 0.92% of the total votes cast for the seat. NCP had a vote share of 40.8% in 2019 in this seat.

In the 2014 Maharashtra Assembly elections, Tukaram Ramchandra Kite of SP won in this seat defeating Nasim Malik of NCP by a margin of 11,007 which was 0.74% of the total votes cast for the seat. SP had a vote share of 29.4% in 2014 in this seat.

In the 2009 Maharashtra Assembly elections, Nasim Malik of NCP won in this seat defeating Kite Tukaram Ramchandra Kite by a margin of 8,20 which was 0.16% of the total votes cast for the seat. NCP had a vote share of 31.32% in 2009 in this seat.

Contesting candidates

A total of 9 candidates were in the fray for the Anushakti Nagar Assembly seat in the 2014 Maharashtra Assembly elections. Acharya Neen Venkatesh (Marathi Nationalist Congress Party), Aditya Malwade (Independent), Arun Joshi (Shiv Sena), Ashok Patil (Independent), Bhagat Singh (Independent), Dr. Jayant Deshmukh (Independent), Ganesh Patil (Independent), Hemant Patil (Independent), Mahadev Appa Kavant (People's Party of India (Deccanist)), Sana Malik (Nationalist Congress Party), Sudhakar Waghela (Independent).

In the 2009 Maharashtra Assembly election, there were 15 candidates from this constituency and in 2014, the number of contestants from this seat was 16, while 11 candidates contested from Anushakti Nagar in 2009.

Constituency profile

(7) Anushakti Nagar is one of the 208 Assembly (Vidhan Sabha) constituencies in Maharashtra. This constituency is located in the Mumbai Thane region of Maharashtra, which is located in the West region of India. This seat can be classified as Urban and falls in the Thane Suburban district of Maharashtra. The reservation status of this constituency in the 2014 Assembly elections was 50% (General) and 50% (Schedule Caste) (General). Lok Sabha constituency also can be classified as Urban. In the 2014 Maharashtra Assembly election, Anushakti Nagar voted on Wednesday, November 20, 2014 and the counting of votes is on Sunday, November 23, 2014.

Demographic profile

There were a total of 1,60,069 registered voters on the electoral rolls for the 2014 Assembly election in Anushakti Nagar Assembly constituency, of which 1,43,444 were male, 125,294 female and 26% of the total gender. In the 2009 Assembly elections, there were a total of 2,10,000 registered voters on the electoral rolls for the 2009 Assembly election, of which 1,85,000 were male and 25,000 were female and 26% of the total gender. In 2014 as well, there were a total of 2,09,000 registered voters in this constituency, of which 1,89,349 were male and 19,650 female. In the 2009 polls, the number of total electors was 2,18,500 which included 1,22,549 males and 1,44,351 females.

The number of service voters in this Assembly constituency was 76 in 2014, 62 in 2014 and 0 in 2009.

The electorate gender ratio (ratio of female voters per 100 male voters) in this constituency in 2014 was 87%, in 2009 it was 94.1, LOKSHU in 2014 and 94.0 in 2009.

Lok Sabha results

Anushakti Nagar Assembly constituency is part of 50. Marathi South-Central (General) Lok Sabha constituency. In the 2014 Lok Sabha elections, SHRI RT was the leading party in this constituency. The leading candidate was Rakesh Deshmukh (INC) with a 50.1% winning, Deshmukh of SHRI Rakesh Deshmukh (INC) with a 50.1%.

In the 2009 Lok Sabha polls, SHRI RT in this constituency against the Marathi South-Central Lok Sabha seat was won by Rakesh Deshmukh of 55 seating Marathi M Gokhale of INC.

In 2014, was won in this particular assembly segment and the Marathi South-Central Lok Sabha constituency was won by Rakesh Deshmukh of 55 seating Marathi M Gokhale of INC.

In the 2009 Parliamentary elections, was the leading party in the Anushakti Nagar constituency as per the Marathi South-Central Lok Sabha constituency was won by Shri RT Gokhale of INC defeating Suresh Anant Gondle of SS.

Voter turnout

According to data released by the Election Commission of India, in the 2014 Maharashtra Assembly elections, the estimated voter turnout in this Maharashtra constituency was 54.00%. In 2009, this seat registered a turnout of 55.00%, while it was 44.70% in 2004 and 44.13% in 2009. The estimated turnout in 2014 was 4.13% compared to the 2009 turnout.

Winner margin

In the 2019 Maharashtra Assembly elections, Nasim Malik of NCP won in this constituency beating Tukaram Ramchandra Kite by a margin of 12,25 which was 0.92% of the total votes cast. In 2014, Tukaram Ramchandra Kite of SP secured a vote share of 31.32% in this constituency. In the 2009 Assembly elections, Nasim Malik of NCP won this seat defeating Kite Tukaram Ramchandra Kite by a margin of 8,20 which was 0.16% of the total votes polled for the seat.

Winner voteshare

In the 2019 Maharashtra Assembly elections, Nasim Malik of NCP had a vote share of 40.8% in this seat. In 2014, Tukaram Ramchandra Kite secured a vote share of 29.4% in this constituency. In the 2009 Assembly elections, Nasim Malik of NCP got a vote share of 31.32% in Anushakti Nagar.

Poll dates

Anushakti Nagar Assembly constituency were to the polls in Phase I of the 2024 Maharashtra Assembly election on Wednesday, November 21, 2024. The counting of votes is on Saturday, November 23, 2024.

In the 2019 state Assembly elections, this seat voted in Phase I on Monday, October 21, 2019 and the results were declared on Thursday, October 24, 2019.

In the 2014 state Assembly elections, this constituency voted in I on Wednesday, October 05, 2014 and the results were declared on Saturday, October 18, 2014.

In 2009, Anushakti Nagar voted in Phase I on Tuesday, October 13, 2009 and the results were disclosed on Sunday, October 18, 2009.

Geographic location

Assembly constituency no.(7) Anushakti Nagar comprises of the following areas of Mumbai Suburban district in the Mumbai Thane region of Maharashtra. Greater Mumbai Municipal Corporation (Part) - Ward No. 1080 (Part - I-B, No. 60 to 110, 124 to 178, 180 to 304, 400 to 404, 418, 407, 1044 to 1057, 1090 to 1099, 124 to 1264, 1227, 1228, 1229, 3501 to 3504).

This constituency covers an approximate area of 34.09 square kilometers.
